Principles for QA of Joint Programmes

- Same principles as for regular provision
 - √ Main responsibility lies within HEI(s)
 - ✓ European Standards and Guidelines (ESG) apply
 - ✓ Primary goal of QA processes should be to enhance quality
- But some additional challenges do exist



Joint Programme: From Planning to Action (1)

- Shared understanding
 - ✓ Careful selection of partners: full institutional support
 - ✓ What are we doing? Developing well-defined programme goals and student-learning outcomes with partners
 - ✓ Why are we doing this? Why a new programme and a joint programme in particular?
 - ✓ Ensuring sufficient academic and administrative resources
 - ✓ Ensuring sustainability of the programme
- Organising Communication
 - ✓ Information accessible for students
 - ✓ Communication and coordination between partners, incl. meetings
 - ✓ Language policy




Joint Programme: From Planning to Action (2)

- Decision-making and levels of responsibility
 - ✓ What is decided at the level of network.
 - ✓ What at the level of subject
 - ✓ What at the level of each institution.
 - ✓ What at national level
- Quality Assurance and Recognition
 - ✓ Need to be planned in advance
 - ✓ Quality assurance consists of two components: internal and external
 - ✓ Regulatory frameworks for external QA and recognition vary

- Programme aims and objectives
 - ✓ Perspective of individual HEI and the network
- Concept
 - √ Target groups/Admission requirements
 - ✓ Course structure
 - ✓ Learning outcomes, ECTS, modular structure
 - ✓ Assessment and examination practices
 - ✓ Learning context
 - ✓ Transparency



Quality Related Questions for Self-evaluation (2)

- Programme Implementation: Tools
 - ✓ Decision-Making Processes
 - ✓ Organisation
 - ✓ Resources
 - √ Staff
 - √ Financial resources
 - ✓ Administration
 - ✓ Organisation of admissions and transitions
- Quality assessment
 - ✓ How is the achievement of programme objectives assessed systematically at all levels involved?
- Programme Sustainability
